	1	A quick fix! Draught-proofing and hole-fixing will help keep the cold out and help to reduce your bills.	£105	316kg	143 miles	14 trees	
	2	Save money with a snappier sing-along! Keeping your showers to 4 minutes means less water, less energy, and less cost.	£75	226kg	102 miles	10 trees	/
	3	Lower the flow. If the water in your radiators is too hot, turning your central heating boiler flow temperature down will help to reduce your bills.*	£112	467kg	204 miles	17 trees	<u> </u>
